WORLD DAY OF THE SICK: Saturday, February 11, 2012 marks the memorial of **Our Lady of Lourdes**. The Church has also designated this as **"World Day of the Sick."** Accordingly, the **Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick** will be offered on this day, immediately **following the Masses at 7:00 a.m., 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.** This sacrament is the proper sacrament **"for those Christians whose health is seriously impaired by sickness or old age."** People who are elderly and in poor health such that sudden illness could be fatal, should receive this sacrament. Adults of any age who have a serious life threatening illness should also receive this sacrament. **Reception of this sacrament, in association with Holy Mass, is open to all regularly practicing Roman Catholics.**
